The Tauwhao Te Ngare Trust Tertiary Education Assistance Grant is for full time students and available from your <u>2nd year</u> of study onwards. Applications close Sunday 30 June 2024.

- (a) This Application Form is to be completed in full and sent to Tauwhao Te Ngare Trust, PO Box 32, Tauranga 3144 or via email to <u>coralie@tauwhaotrust.co.nz</u>
- (b) The application must be accompanied by proof of enrolment for the current year, a <u>full</u> <u>Invoice for the current year</u>, and your previous year's academic results.
- (c) The applicant must submit a covering letter and a CV providing additional information to assist in the selection process.
- (d) The Tertiary Education Assistance Grant is available only to students undertaking a <u>full time</u> Degree or Diploma Course at a recognised Tertiary Institution.
- (e) The Applicant must be an owner or descendant of an owner in the Tauwhao Te Ngare Trust.
- (f) In order to receive an Education Grant, eligible applicants will need to confirm their attendance at the Trusts Annual General Meeting being held in October 2024. If attendance in person is not practicable, a member of the applicant's whanau may attend on your behalf. Non representation at the AGM is deemed as <u>not</u> fulfilling the criteria.
- (g) The Selection Panel's decision is final and any incomplete applications <u>will not</u> be considered.
